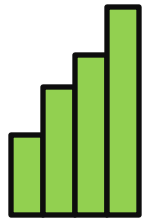


Connecting to Internet



This icon


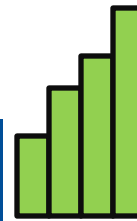


If you hover your mouse over this icon when the bars are GREEN it should tell you what wireless router it is connected to, the speed, your signal strength, the status and the IP address.


